- <u>Dues</u> left in the mailbox at the front gate, put in the Gatehouse or Office door <u>will not be accepted!</u>
- Check/Money Order's are to be made payable to the South Wilmington Firemen's Beach & Park Club. If purchasing **Raffle Tickets**, at \$ 5.00 each, you may combine your total payment on the same check.
- Senior Discount is available to any <u>member and/or spouse who is 65 years' age or older and has been a</u> <u>member of the club, in good standing, for 10 years or more as of March 1st of current year.</u> In order to obtain the discount, you will need to provide a copy of your Driver's license or State issued ID card at the time dues are paid. Failure to provide this documentation will result in Full dues to be paid.
- The enclosed Membership Information Update Sheet <u>MUST BE</u> <u>Completed</u>, <u>Signed & Returned</u> with your payment in order for your Membership to be considered renewed. <u>ALL</u> BLANKS <u>MUST BE</u> FILLED OUT <u>AND</u> ANY REQUIRED DOCUMENTATION (DRIVER'S LICENSE/ID, COLLEGE CLASS SCHEDULE, MILTARY, ETC) <u>MUST BE</u> RETURNED WITH YOUR DUES. <u>FAILURE TO DO SO WILL RESULT IN YOUR MEMBERSHIP BEING CHARGED IN FULL OR A LATE FEE MAYBE CHARGED.</u>

BOATS & DOCKS

- Members who have <u>either</u> a <u>Permanent or Temporary Speed Boat Sticker</u> are required to provide proof of a minimum of \$ 300,000.00 liability insurance and have your Boat stickered with the <u>Club Office Only</u>, By <u>JUNE 1st!</u> Failure to registered your boat may result in loss of <u>Permanent or Temporary Boat Sticker</u>.
- All people on the water are required to have a life jacket or belt on. Life preservers that require a cord to be pulled for activation are not allowed.
- Members Club Card numbers must be on ALL boats.
- Due to Safety issues, Kayaks/Canoes <u>WILL NOT</u> be PERMITTED in <u>Incline II</u>. They may be used in Incline I, III or Lakes only.
- Incline I is a No Wake / Trolling Motor only area. This will be strictly enforced.

BEACH DEPARTMENT

- The <u>Beach opens</u> Saturday, May 27th and closes Monday, September 4th; hours are 10 a.m. 8 p.m. Monday Sunday and Holidays (weather permitting). Beach hours are subject to change in August due to Lifeguards returning to school, the revised hours will be posted.
- <u>Swimming Lessons</u> will be held *Monday*, *July 10th* through *Friday*, *July 21st*. A fee will be charged for each student. Registration for swimming lessons is done through the Lifeguards at the Beach.
- Last season many issues had to be addressed around the beach area. Parents please watch your children, the Lifeguards **ARE NOT** babysitters, No food, or drinks (INCLUDING ALCOHOL) are to be brought around the beach area. Please help us to keep this area SAFE. Failure to do so **WILL** result in termination of your Membership.

TRAILERS, CABINS, CAMPERS, TENTS

• Campers <u>MUST BE</u> registered annually, at the Club Office. Providing proof of \$300,000 Liability Insurance, *CURRENT* Registration and the signing of a camping agreement are also required.

- Camping fees are \$\frac{4.00/\day}{400/\day}\$ for Electric camping areas and \$\frac{3.00/\day}{400/\day}\$ for Non-Electric areas. You must reregister your camper every two weeks, if you are late on your camping fees you will be charged a total of \$10.00/\day\$ in camping fees for every day you are overdue.
- <u>ALL</u> campers <u>MUST BE</u> removed from Camping Area #3 by *Monday, June 5th* and cannot move back into the area until *Monday, June 19th at 8:00 a.m.* If you were in Camping Area 3 prior to having to leave, you will have 1st opportunity to go back to your original spot. Camping Area 3 will Open up to all other Campers or those wishing to change their spot, as of *Noon on Tuesday, June 20th*.
- Camping Season begins 8 a.m. on March 31st and ends 6 p.m. on October 31st. Call the Club Office for exact dates and procedure.
- ALL waste water must be disposed of properly.
- Trailers and Boats are <u>NOT</u> to be Parked/Stored around your camper. These must be parked in the designated parking areas. THIS WILL BE ENFORCED!

ROADS

- <u>Four Wheelers, Golf Carts</u> & <u>Snowmobiles MUST</u> have the Club Members card number affixed to them in clear view, additionally an <u>operating brake light</u> as well as <u>operating front and rear lights</u> are required to operate these vehicles on Club roads.
- ONLY LICENSED CLUB MEMBERS ARE AUTHORIZED TO OPERATE THESE VEHICLES.
- Speed Limits are <u>20 mph</u> on the hard surfaced roads and <u>10 mph</u> on gravel roadways. These speed limits <u>Will Be</u> strictly enforced.
- **ABSOLUTELY NO** hill climbing is allowed.

MISCELLANEOUS

- Opening day of **Trout Season** is *Saturday*, *April 1st 8 a.m.*
- The Kid's Fishing Derby is scheduled for Saturday, June 17th with a rain date of Sunday, June 18th.
- The picnic tables located up front have been painted a different color. These tables **ARE NOT** to be removed from this area.
- If you would like to Reserve the Pavilion or Picnic area, please contact the Club Office to do so. We only allow Three (3) Picnics scheduled per day.
